Registration & Cost:

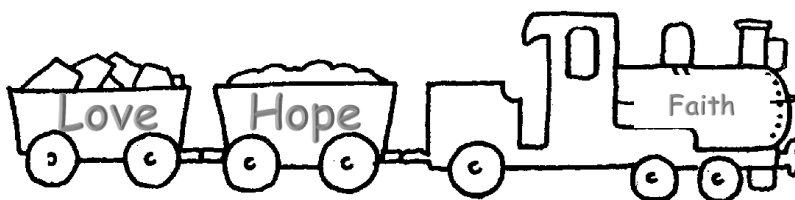
- You may register your camper at www.gasconadevalleybaptist.org and bring your form and camp fee on June 25th

- If the camper needs financial assistance, talk with your pastor, camp director Jason, or GVBA Director of Missions Phil Rector.

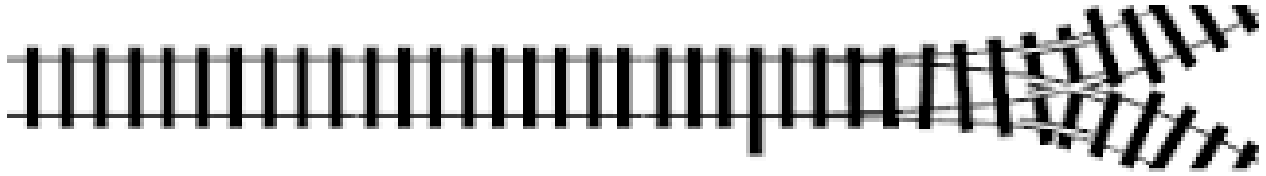
Time:

- Thursday (Day 5):** GOOD BYE! - wear your camp t-shirt...from this year or previous years!

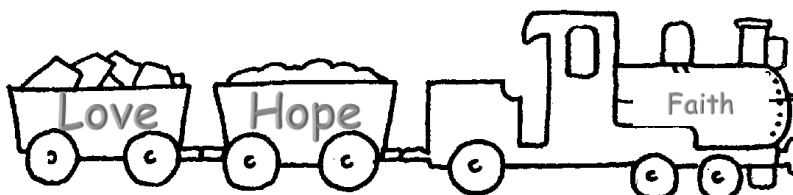
WHAT TO BRING...

- **YOUR BIBLES...**
- **Clothing:** Modest clothing and in keeping with Christian standards. No vulgarity, cussing, or profanity is to be on the clothing. No short shorts or halter tops...or tops with spaghetti straps. If you can't wear it to school please don't wear it to camp. Swimsuits should be one piece and not French cut. Those with two piece or French cut swimsuits will be expected to wear a t-shirt at the pool. Bring a jacket or sweater in case of cool nights. Please also bring at least one pair of shoes that can be run in and that won't fall apart.
- **Personal items:** toothbrush, toothpaste, soap, wash cloths, towels, shampoo, and any other hygiene product.
 - **Bedding:** sleeping bag OR sheets, blankets and pillow
 - **Optional:** notebook, pen or pencil, fans, bug spray, flashlight, clothes hangers, water bottle (marked with camper's name)

WHAT NOT TO BRING...

Electronic devices (iPod, game boys, cell phones, etc.), fireworks, any type of weapon, tobacco, drugs, or money.
