2018 YOUTH CAMP WHAT TO & NOT TO BRING**

Camp Dates: July 8th (Sun.) – July 13th (Friday.)

This camp is for boys and girls who have completed 6th-12th grades

Activities for camp: water games, team-building exercises, messy games, outdoor sports, indoor sports, swimming, hiking, Bible study's, worship, meals, sleeping, movie-nights, & bon-fires. Camp Drivers will be driving all students to and from activities. A student who drives him or herself to camp will not be allowed to drive off-sight unless required to go to a job. A note from parents will be required with work dates and times that the student is to report to work with the parent's signature. **Keys for vehicles of students will have to be turned in at the beginning of camp.**

Campers will need: bathroom necessities (shampoo, soap, towels, toothpaste, deodorant, toothbrush, hair products and accessories), change of clothes for activities involving sweat, getting dirty/messy, getting wet, shoes for running and walking, clean clothes for each day of camp, towels for swimming and showering, sleeping materials (sleeping bag or sheets, pillow, blanket), notebook, pen, Bible, water bottle (a water bottle will not be provided this year at camp), flashlight, bug spray, sun-tan lotion, swimming suits (**no 2-piece suits for girls**, girls with a 2-piece suit will be required to wear a dark color t-shirt to cover, no speedos for boys), sunglasses or a hat. We will have a dress up day (no formal wear and no thin strapped or strapless dresses)

Campers should NOT bring: iPod, iPad, e-readers, mp3 players, reading material of questionable nature, I-phones, **cell phones**, computers, game devices. ***All of these types of materials will be checked in at registration and held by the Camp Leader until the close of camp on Friday. No campers are not allowed to have a cell phone while on camp grounds.*** There is also a land-line phone at the camp. Campers should also not bring materials for practical jokes such as masks, costumes or any sort of spraying materials. No weapons (of any kind) are allowed during camp hours.

Campers can bring (but not required to): camera, money for refreshments at the swimming pool, snacks for between meals.

At camp every student will be required to be in their cabin at a specific time each night. If any camper is found or information is given about a camper being outside of their cabin (unless given permission by their cabin leader), that camper will immediately be asked to have a ride come and pick them up.

Campers will be required to clean up their cabins and any debris scattered on the camp property at the close of camp on Friday before leaving.

Camp registration begins at 3:30 pm Sunday, July 8th and camp closes at noon on Friday, July 13th.
