


MID-YEAR MEETING



GASCONADE VALLEY ASSOCIATION SPONSORED MISSION TRIP TO HANNIBAL

Monday through Friday, June 5–9 are the dates of our twenty-second Annual Mission Trip to Hannibal-LaGrange University, Hannibal, Missouri.

The college provides for us: (1) lunch, plus, morning and afternoon snacks Monday through Friday. (2) RV parking with water and electric hook-ups, and a dump station. Gray water may be run on the ground. (3) Those who do not have RVs will be housed in Memorial Hall, which has individual room controlled air conditioners, private rooms with private baths. It has a small kitchen available (equipped with ref/freezer, microwaves, stoves, coffee maker, toast-

er, and limited cooking and eating utensils) where you may prepare the other meals. Paper goods and plastic ware, along with the coffee, etc. will be provided. If you want to eat some meals out, places are available nearby. (4) The dorm is complete with linens. Dorm rooms will not be available until Sunday afternoon.

The only cost will be your travel to and from Hannibal and your food for breakfast and the evening meals. Most everyone arrives on Saturday or Sunday.

You will recall this is basically an adult mission trip that includes couples, singles and families. Youth are only includ-

ed when they come to work with a parent or sponsor. Children and youth that are left unsupervised during the week, can become a safety risk to themselves and others. The school policy is: everyone under 18 years of age needs to be under the constant supervision and guidance of an adult.

ASSOCIATIONAL EMPHASIS WEEK MAY 21—27

The Churches of the Southern Baptist Convention will be celebrating Associational Emphasis Week on May 21—27.

Local churches and the association have formed a partnership in sharing the gospel within the United States and around the world. The association provides leadership training, pastoral support, church fellowship, mission opportunities, and communication.

The Gasconade Valley Baptist Association exists to encourage, equip, and assist churches to carry out the Great Commission.

The Gasconade Valley Association was organized as a "missionary association" in 1875. In 1879 there were thirteen churches and 429 members. Today there are twenty-five churches with 4,128 members. The boundaries have changed, but the goal of the association remains the same.
